MISSION

DPF supports and uplifts children and their families through sports and recreation programs that allow them to heal, grow, and play.



WORK

We remove barriers to play by fully funding sports, recreation, and fitness programs in Title-I schools and low-income communities, and by providing scholarships for sports programs and camps. In addition, we offer programs to support and uplift grieving children, in partnership with other orgs.

Impact Summary

2025 was another year of expansion for DPF, with our sports and rec programs growing to 18 weekly "clubs," in 15 Title-I schools. Adding new programs and expanding to new schools resulted in more children PLAYing this year up from approximately 350 children in 2024 to over 500 children in 2025. Further, we project that the total number of children served in the 2025/2026 school year, will exceed 700.

PROGRAMS

DPF provides quality sports, recreation, and fitness programs in Title-I schools and low-income communities, and works to ensure opportunities to PLAY for children all across Austin.

Year End Stats

Through partnerships with 7 sports and rec providers, and employing 26 teachers as program leaders and assistants, DPF provided over 500 children with opportunities to play in 2025, with projections to serve over 700 kids by the end of this school year.


