<input type="checkbox"/> Tennis shoes - white, gray, or black athletic shoes combination of three colors above is acceptable <u>no other colors in shoes or laces will be allowed</u>	
<input type="checkbox"/> 2 Master Locks (short shank) with 2 keys each. (SEE BELOW)	
<input type="checkbox"/> Current prescribed medication in original containers with original labels. Parents are responsible for refills. Bring any ADD/ADHD medication you have whether you are taking it or not. <u>Parents should bring a current list of medications, dosage and diagnosis.</u>	
<input type="checkbox"/> Glasses and contacts - bring supplies for maintaining them. If you have extra bring them in case of an emergency.
