The meeting began with greetings from everyone. Mr. Brian Ferguson then informed everyone that the meeting would be recorded.

CEO Report: Brian Ferguson

· Introduced the agenda, starting with Ms. Patino's presentation on the IB program.

IB Report: Gina Patino

- · Discussed the adoption of a new learning management system, Toddle, after an eight-week pilot period. Toddle is praised for its user-friendliness and ability to manage digital student portfolios.
- · Mentioned updates to the IB program, with full implementation by September 2027. The updates aim to increase student agency and create globally connected units.
- · OWN 1 Fifth grade exhibition will open to the community for the first time on June 18th.
- · OWN 2 is currently preparing for IB authorization with a final consultation meeting scheduled.

OWN 1 ES Updates: Stephanie Rochman

- · Announced that she has been selected to be the permanent principal starting next school year with Mr. Christopher Palmisano as the assistant principal.
- · Professional development on IB policies, particularly the Language Policy and Academic Integrity Policy, is emphasized.
- The school has implemented inquiry-based approaches and showcases for students to present their learning.
- · Parent engagement activities include IB parent chats and collaborative efforts like an IB bulletin board.

OWN 2 Updates: Anita Angrum

- · Discussed the three main goals: safeguarding students, academic excellence, and parent outreach.
- · Parent outreach includes monthly meetings and meet-and-greet sessions to foster communication and engagement.
- · Monthly coffee chats and academic workshops are part of the parent engagement efforts.
- The school collaborates with Child Mind Institute for additional support.
- There was a 76% increase in i-Ready scores for sixth graders, 46% for seventh graders, and 57% for eighth graders.

Finance Report: Keith Alves

- · Introduced as the new director of Finance
- ·Presented a financial overview for the current fiscal year.
- · Gross revenues are at \$27 million, with expenditures slightly above \$26 million, resulting in a net income of \$1 million.
- \cdot The budget is based on a full enrollment of 1600 students, with the current enrollment at 86%, or 1376 FTEs of students.
- The impact of rental assistance on the budget performance is discussed, with specific details provided for each school.
- The importance of accurate financial reporting and budget management is emphasized, with efforts to ensure the school's financial stability.
