1 GENERAL EDUCATION

United Nursing College offers prerequisite courses designed to meet the requirements for our nursing programs. Our General Education courses provide essential skills in communication, critical reasoning, mathematics, science, and social awareness, placing students on a path to success in both their academic and career journeys.

2 PRE-LICENSURE ASSOCIATE DEGREE IN NURSING (ADN)

The Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) program is a pre-licensure program that consists of four semesters of didactic, laboratory, and clinical instruction. The curriculum covers fundamentals of nursing, medical-surgical, pediatrics, obstetrics, geriatrics, and behavioral health, focusing on cultural competence and ethical standards of care. Upon graduation, students will be prepared to apply for national licensure known as the NCLEX-RN.

3 ADVANCED PLACEMENT PATHWAY

The Advanced Placement (AP) Pathway is designed and built specifically for qualified Military Healthcare Professionals, Licensed Vocational Nurses, and Paramedics who want to transition to their ADN degree. Successful completion of our entire workshop series is required prior to applying to our highly competitive Advanced Placement Pathway. The series is skillfully designed with didactic and laboratory instruction and will evaluate student readiness for Advanced Placement into the ADN Program.

4 RN TO BSN DEGREE

This is a program intended for Registered Nurses who are seeking a Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree (BSN). The ADN to BSN program is designed to prepare registered nurses to advance empirical knowledge based on evidence-based research.
