

# **Advanced Placement FAQs**

#### Which semester will I be placed into?

Depending on how well you do in the workshop series will determine your placement in the Advanced Placement Pathway.

### Am I guaranteed a seat in the pathway after the workshop series?

Completing the workshop series does not guarantee a spot in the Advanced Placement Pathway.

### How long is the workshop series good for?

2 years

### Do I automatically start the pathway in 3rd semester?

To be considered for advanced placement into third semester, students must receive a passing score of 70% or higher on examination #4 which covers obstetric and pediatric content. No minimum scores required for any other examinations. Your comprehensive workshop score will determine which semester you are placed into.

### Can I apply to the workshop series if my prerequisites are not completed?

Prerequisites must be completed prior to applying to the workshop series

#### How many seats are available in the workshop series?

There will be 30 seats available in the Spring 2025 workshop series and going forward there will be 25 seats

## What happens if I don't get into the pathway once I complete the workshop series?

Students will be eligible to reapply to the pathway for up to 2 years, upon completion of the workshop series

#### How do I qualify for the workshop series?

Completion of all prerequisites are required to apply to the workshop series, along with a current unencumbered license and 1 year of full-time employment verification within the past 3 years.

## What if my Anatomy & Physiology are expired?

If your Anatomy & Physiology are more than 7 years old, you can take our non-transferrable refresher courses.

## If I am enrolled in the A&P refreshers, am I able to still apply for the workshop series?

If you are enrolled in the A&P refreshers for recency **only**, then you may apply for the workshop series. Verification of enrollment is required.



### Do I have to take the HESI entrance exam?

The HESI entrance exam is not required

## Can I do a payment plan or use financial aid for the workshop series?

We do not accept payment plans or financial aid for the workshop series

### How often do I have to come to campus?

You can expect to be on campus 8 full days. Each day is scheduled to occur very other week over the span of 16 weeks

### How many hours should I expect for in class and outside homework?

You can expect to be on campus 8 hours for lecture and skills validation. There will be no outside homework scheduled, however, you should plan to study for all examinations.

### Can I retake a single examination or skill within the workshops to better my grade?

No, the workshops need to be taken as a whole.

## Am I allowed to miss a workshop day?

Students are responsible for any missed content and will be required to schedule any makeup exams at the discretion of the instructor's schedule. Students that miss an exam will automatically have a 10% point deduction from the missed exam.

## Is there a comprehensive final at the end of the Workshop Series?

No. There will be no outside homework scheduled, however, you should plan to study for all examinations.

## Is there homework associated with the Workshop Series?
